Satisfying Regents' Test Requirements – National Test Scores

Effective Summer 2003, the Board of Regents updated the Regents' Test policy to include the option for students to satisfy the essay and writing sections with appropriate standardized test scores. Listed below are the tests and scores required to satisfy the Regents' Reading or Writing requirements. Test scores must be from a national test administration. If you entered AASU prior to Summer 2003 and have met the exemption criteria listed below, please complete this form and submit to the Registrar's Office. Indicate below the section(s) of the Regents' Test you are requesting to be satisfied via test scores.

_____ **Regents' Reading Requirement:**

Students with SAT I Verbal scores of at least 510 or ACT Reading scores of at least 23 will be considered to have fulfilled the reading comprehension requirement for the Regents' Test and do not need to take the reading portion of the Regents' Test. (Scores from an institutional SAT (ISAT) or residual ACT tests will not be acceptable for this purpose.)

_____ **Regents' Writing Requirement:**

Students with College Board Advanced Placement (AP) English scores of at least 3, International Baccalaureate (IB) higher-level English scores of at least 4, or SAT II English Writing scores of at least 650 will be considered as having fulfilled the essay requirement of the Regents' Test and do not need to take the essay portion of the Regents' Test.
